

Ringmer Police Report 01/05/2025 – 05/06/2025

- 3/5/25: Report of a car parked on a resident's front lawn in Middleham Way, it belonged to another resident of the same road.
- 4/5/25: Report of £24,000 of diesel stolen from Clay hill service station overnight.
- 7/5/25: Report of a road traffic collision on Harrisons Lane between a cyclist and a car, the cyclist fractured their ankle.
- 14/5/25: Report of a group of youths loitering in the grounds of Delves house, when asked to leave by residents they got abusive Police attended but youths had gone.
- 16/5/25: Report of a deliberate fire in the undergrowth behind the building site on Bishops Lane, Fire service attended and put fire out.
- 19/5/25: Further report of 3 youths fishing in the private pond at Delves house, residents told them to leave and some pushing and shoving occurred a resident punched one of the youths and the youth punched him back. Police are investigating.
