- Fears of drought has raised its head. Having only recently seen the end of a hosepipe ban, there is considerable concern about water supply given the dry Spring we have had. I'm pursuing a reality check from the water companies and will be attending their water catchment plan session soon.
- I have had queries about whether RPC has submitted plans to take over the allotments off Green Close/Lewes Road. I believe these would be better managed by Ringmer PC so keen to know if there is anything I can do on this front.
- I have visited Almond Field and wanted to give a shout out to Cllr Duke and Anne Duke and any others who put the work in for such an amazing spot!
