Clerk's report - Full Council Meeting 11th November 2025

- 10.1 In prior years, the Anchor Inn has generously supplied a Christmas tree and lights for the Village Green on behalf of the Parish Council. For the current year, and going forward, the Parish Council will take responsibility for this task. Requests for quotations regarding the supply, delivery, and removal of a 20-foot Christmas tree with lights were sent to four different vendors; the submitted quotes can be found in the supporting documents. The budget allocation was based on prior years, so additional funding will be required.
- 10.2 Cheyney Trust, Ringmer Cricket Club, Bowls Club, Scouts, and Croquet Club have reported that all storm water is finding its way into Cheyney Field, the lowest point of the area. This has resulted in significant issues for cricket matches and created difficulties for members of the croquet club accessing the field. Additionally, pooling and water ingress are affecting both the bowls rink and the car park. Several potential solutions are currently being pursued by the clubs; however, a key improvement would be to clear and maintain the ditch located in front of the Bowls Club. Regular maintenance of this ditch would help redirect water away from the Bowls Rink and subsequently reduce the amount reaching Cheyney Field.

 An initial quote has been obtained to clear the ditch see supporting papers.
- 10.4 This project was investigated before the current Clerk was in situ. We are often told that residents are still unaware of the office location, and it would be good to heighten our profile. An updated quote has been provided by ESCC for consideration
