### **Lewes District Council Local Plan Phase 2 Consultation**

#### **DO YOU WANT RINGMER TO BECOME A TOWN???**

The LDC Local Plan proposes the allocation of sites for more than 2,200 additional homes in Ringmer. Don't miss this opportunity to participate in this consultation and provide your feedback regarding the proposed developments and the future of Ringmer.

**The Consultation deadline is Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2026**

This document will shape the future of our village and whilst the scale and detail of documentation contained in the consultation may appear daunting, it is important that as many residents as possible respond. To that end Ringmer Parish Council are preparing a leaflet to be delivered to all households to explain what this means for the village.

There will be a meeting hosted by **Lewes District Council** at

**Ringmer Village Hall on Saturday February 7th from 10am until 2pm**

which will include a presentation and Q&A session. Maps and Local Plan literature will be on show and Officers available to answer your questions. This is an opportunity to speak directly to the authors of the plan and make your thoughts known. RPC Councillors will also be attending + Cllr West will be available with information about Ringmer's emerging Neighbourhood Plan review.

There will also be some sessions held at the library where a Councillor will be available to help residents navigate the LDC consultation portal. The library computers can be utilised for response.
