Picnic on The Green

Refreshments will be available, including ice creams, jacket potatoes, tea and cakes from the WI Tea Stand, and a licensed bar run by Ringmer Cricket Club.

A large marquee will be available on the Green if shelter is needed, though we hope the fine weather continues.
